What FTTH Is FTTH, also called Fiber to the Premises (FTTP), involves running fiber optic cables directly from the Internet Service Provider (ISP) to your home, bypassing copper or coaxial lines entirely. This direct connection ensures maximum performance, minimal signal loss, and the ability to support high-bandwidth applications like 4K streaming, online gaming, video conferencing, and smart home devices. Unlike Fiber to the Node (FTTN), which uses fiber only to a neighborhood node and then copper to homes, FTTH provides a 100% fiber path, resulting in faster and more reliable internet.

How Fiber Reaches Your Home The process begins at the ISP's central office, where data travels through the fiber network to neighborhood distribution points. From there, the fiber is extended to individual homes using a drop cable, which is smaller and flexible but robust enough for outdoor conditions. The drop cable can be installed:

- Through a wall:** A small hole is drilled in the exterior wall, and the fiber is fed inside, sealed with a weatherproof grommet.
- Through an existing conduit:** If a conduit for cable or telephone lines exists, the fiber can be pulled through it, avoiding new drilling.

Fiber can be installed underground via trenching or directional boring, or aerially along utility poles, depending on local infrastructure and ISP deployment strategy.

Home Equipment At the home, the fiber terminates at an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which converts light signals into digital data for your router. A compatible router or mesh Wi-Fi system is recommended to ensure whole-home coverage and maintain high-speed performance across multiple devices.
