It serves as a junction between incoming feeder cables and outgoing pigtails or patch cords, ensuring secure and efficient signal distribution while protecting fibers from physical damage, dust, and moisture.

Primary Termination Methods

Connector Termination

Involves attaching a connector to the fiber end to create a removable joint. Commonly used for patching and temporary connections. Requires precise fiber cleaving, cleaning, and polishing to minimize insertion loss and back reflection. Tools include precision cleavers, polishing films, and visual fault locators (VFLs) to verify fiber integrity.

Splicing

Fusion splicing is the most common method, permanently joining two bare fibers. Provides low-loss, high-reliability connections. Requires a fusion splicer, fiber holders, electrodes, and protective sleeves to secure the splice. Splicing is often used to connect incoming fibers to pre-terminated pigtails inside the FTB.

Installation and Cable Management in FTBs

Cable Preparation:

Strip the fiber jacket, clean the fiber, and slide the connector housing or boot onto the cable before termination.

Routing and Protection:

Fibers are guided through plastic posts or trays inside the box to prevent bending or stress. Excess fiber is coiled and stored safely.

Splice Trays:

Used to hold fusion splices and pigtails securely, often with protective sleeves to prevent damage.

Box Types:

Terminal boxes can be straight-through (single entry) or branched-type (multiple entries), with varying port counts (e.g., 2-96 ports) depending on network requirements.

Environmental Protection:

Outdoor FTBs require IP-rated housings that are dust-proof, watertight, and resistant to temperature fluct...
