Meter Box Grounding The meter box, or service entrance equipment, is the point where utility power connects to the premises wiring. Key grounding requirements include: Connecting the grounding electrode conductor (GEC) from the meter box or main service panel to a grounding electrode, such as a ground rod or UFER (concrete-encased electrode) Ensuring the GEC is mechanically secure, corrosion-resistant, and sized according to NEC standards based on the largest ungrounded service conductors Installing the ground rod at least 2 feet from the building foundation, with a minimum of 8 feet in continuous contact with soil, either vertically or at an angle not exceeding 45 degrees Bonding the neutral conductor to the equipment grounding conductor at the service disconnect or meter socket, depending on local utility requirements, to maintain a proper ground-fault path

Distribution Box Grounding The distribution box, which distributes power to branch circuits, must also be reliably grounded: The grounding wire should have sufficient cross-sectional area and be connected to the building's grounding network All metallic parts inside the distribution box should be bonded to...
