Fiber End Preparation: The fiber end is cleaved and polished to a smooth, mirror-like finish to minimize signal loss and prevent defects such as hackles or lips.

Connector Types: Different connectors (SC, ST, LC, FC) may have variations in ferrule size, housing design, and locking mechanisms, but the core sheath components remain consistent.
