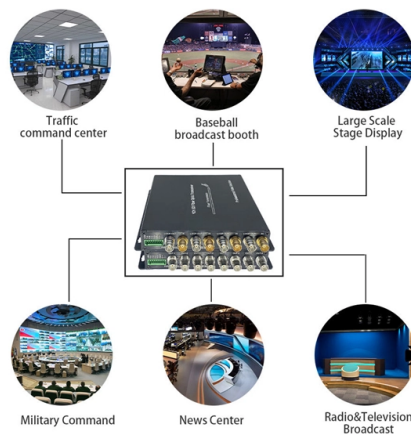


The grounding wire of the distribution box is white

Grounding of the units: Attach a ground wire from one of the threaded studs (A) at the bottom of the housing, to the mounting plate (B). (Exhibit 1) The hot and the neutral make the circuit “complete” to light. Why are Neutral and Ground Wires Separated in a Subpanel?

According to NEC Article 250, neutral and ground wires must remain separate in subpanels. Bonding (connecting) the neutral and ground should only occur in the main panel or at the first service

How & Why to Ground Wiring

Install grounding wire to provide a current with alternate paths to avoid electrical shocks in case of power surges. Run ground wires parallel to hot and neutral wires in a branch circuit. Connect

Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm 2 (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm 2 must be used.
