

The spectrometer does not emit light



Overview

Most spectrometer problems stem from three things: incorrect calibration, poor sample prep, or hardware wear. If your UV reading is drifting or results are inconsistent across runs, it's time to recalibrate using certified standards. The grating or prism splits the light into its constituent wavelength components, and the detector records the light intensity. Allow for Warm-Up: Always turn on your spectrophotometer and let its lamps warm up for at least 15–30 minutes before use. Handle Cuvettes with Care: Cuvettes are precision optical components. During a self-test, the UV-Vis spectrophotometer fails the stray light and wavelength repeatability tests with an “NG9” message. After the self-test, “Error Code = 24” appears, asking whether to continue.
