Practical Considerations: While these standards provide a framework, fiber optic cables often require additional testing for mechanical impact, crush resistance, UV exposure, and temperature extremes to ensure suitability for industrial tray applications. Many manufacturers offer LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen) or riser-rated cables that meet these criteria and are explicitly tested for tray use.
