The “on” position is usually marked or oriented consistently across the panel. **Labeling:** Many distribution boxes have labels indicating which circuit each breaker controls, helping identify which circuits are active. **Testing:** Use a non-contact voltage tester or multimeter to confirm if a circuit is live. In summary, the main switch must be on for any circuit to receive power, and individual MCBs or RCCBs in the “on” position indicate which circuits are currently active. Always ensure safety precautions when inspecting or operating a distribution box.
