- 1. Single-Phase Wiring (1P Breakers)** Used in residential lighting and general-purpose circuits. Only the live conductor is interrupted; the neutral connects directly to the neutral bar. Simple, cost-effective, and widely used in homes.
- 2. Two-Pole Wiring (2P Breakers)** Disconnects both line and neutral simultaneously, providing full isolation. Applied to socket circuits, water heaters, or as a main switch in smaller boards. Offers higher safety during maintenance or fault conditions.
- 3. Three-Phase Wiring** Common in commercial and industrial installations. Uses three live wires (L1, L2, L3) and a neutral. Requires careful load balancing to prevent neutral overheating and system instability. Suitable for heavy machinery, elevators, and high-power equipment.
- 4. Split-Load Configuration** Divides circuits across multiple RCDs to prevent total power loss during a fault. Example: upstairs lights on one RCD, downstairs on another. Enhances safety and convenience by isolating only the affected circuit.
- 5. RCBO-Based Wiring** RCBOs combine overload and residual current protection for individual circuits. Ideal for sensitive or outdoor circuits, ensuring only the faulty circuit trips while others remain operational.
