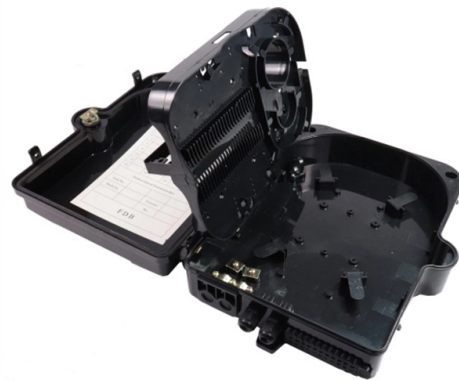

Role of Optical Modules in an ONU The optical module in an ONU acts as the "eyes" of the device, enabling electro-optical conversion. It receives downstream optical signals from the OLT and converts them into electrical signals for end-user devices, and it also converts upstream electrical signals back into optical signals for transmission to the OLT. These modules contain lasers for transmitting light and photodetectors for receiving light, ensuring accurate and high-speed data communication over fiber networks. Types of Optical Modules Modern ONUs often support pluggable modules such as SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) or SFP+, which provide flexibility for upgrades and compatibility with different PON standards. The choice of module depends on the network type and speed requirements: GPON ONU: Uses modules compatible with ITU-T G.984 standard, typically 2.5 Gbps downstream and 1.25 Gbps upstream. EPON ONU: Uses IEEE 802.3ah/av-compliant modules for Ethernet-native PON networks. XGS-PON ONU: Supports symmetric 10 Gbps upstream and downstream, requiring higher-performance optical modules. NG-PON2 and emerging 25G/50G-PON: Use WDM-based or high-speed pluggable modules for multiple 10 Gbps channels per fiber. Advantages of Pluggable Modules Pluggable SFP/SFP+ modules allow ONUs to be easily upgraded or replaced without changing the entire device. This modularity supports evolving broadband needs, including ultra-HD video, AI, VR/AR applications, and future high-speed internet services. It also simplifies maintenance and ensures compatibility with different OLTs and PON standards.
