

Thickness requirements for fireproof partitions for cable trays

The packing thickness for firestopping at slab penetrations is typically 20–30 millimeters, and all gaps must be tightly sealed to prevent smoke and flame penetration . Cover plates should be square, properly sized, and painted evenly to close openings effectively . Summary To comply with fire safety standards, a fireproof partition for cable trays should be at least 10 mm thick, properly positioned, securely fixed, and complemented with appropriate firestopping materials to ensure full protection against fire spread along cable routes .
