Cable Securing Cables in vertical trays should be fastened to transverse members to prevent sagging and maintain spacing, which improves heat dissipation and reduces mechanical strain (). Unsupported spans should not exceed 6 feet when transitioning to equipment or other raceways; additional supports are required if this distance is exceeded (). Material Selection Choose tray materials based on environmental conditions and load requirements. Common options include aluminum, steel, or FRP, with aluminum offering excellent corrosion resistance due to its natural oxide layer (). Metallic trays can also serve as equipment grounding conductors if they meet NEC requirements (). Cable Types and Fill Limits Only use conductors rated for open-air environments, such as Tray Rated (Type TC) or Metal-Clad (Type MC) cables (). Fill limits should not exceed 40% for power cables and 50% for control cables to prevent overheating and maintain proper airflow ().
