Avoid over-tightening ties to prevent cable damage. Leave enough slack for thermal expansion and maintenance access. Use strain relief at the top and bottom of vertical runs to prevent stress on cable terminations. Follow NEC and local codes: Ensure vertical trays remain accessible, maintain required clearances, and use tray-rated cables. Periodic inspection: Check bindings for wear, UV degradation, or loosening over time, especially in outdoor or industrial environments.
