Clearance Requirements: Vertical cable trays should maintain a minimum height of 2.2 meters above the ground, with at least 0.3 meters clearance from ceilings or other obstructions. In concealed installations, such as suspended ceilings, a vertical clear space of 80 mm should be maintained, and the tray fill rate should not exceed 50% to allow for ventilation.

Material Considerations: In the Bahamas, where high humidity and salt-laden air can accelerate corrosion, aluminum or fiberglass-reinforced plastic (FRP) trays are recommended for their corrosion resistance and durability. Aluminum provides a natural oxide layer that protects against atmospheric agents, while FRP is non-conductive and highly resistant to moisture.

Bonding and Grounding: All vertical cable trays must be bonded and grounded according to NEC and NEMA VE 2 standards. Bonding jumpers should be installed at expansion joints and at intervals of approximately 15 meters...
