- Compatibility and Power Requirements:** QSFP-DD modules and switches must meet MSA standards for electrical signaling, power delivery, and mechanical design to ensure proper operation. Using incompatible modules or exceeding power specifications may void warranty coverage.
- Module Classes:** Modern QSFP-DD modules fall into Class 6–8 power categories (10–25W per port). Switches not designed for these power classes may fail to recognize modules, which could affect warranty claims if improper module usage is involved.
- Backwards Compatibility:** QSFP-DD switches are designed to support legacy QSFP modules, but warranty coverage may be limited if non-certified modules are used.
