Circuit breakers and fuses for protection against overloads and faults. Busbars and connectors to distribute power to multiple feeders. Monitoring and control units for grid management and safety. Enclosures designed to withstand environmental conditions, including heat, humidity, and dust common in West Africa. These boxes may be indoor or outdoor, depending on the installation site and local climate.
