

What are the width and height of a trough-type cable tray

- Medium-duty trays:** moderate thickness for standard industrial or commercial installations.
- Heavy-duty trays:** thicker material for high cable loads or outdoor/industrial environments.

Additional Considerations

- Cable fill:** The usable area is slightly less than the nominal width due to perforations and sidewall height, so calculate cable cross-sectional area carefully.
- Heat dissipation:** Adequate ventilation is essential to prevent overheating, especially for power cables.
- Future expansion:** Oversizing slightly can accommodate additional cables without requiring tray replacement.
