

What cables should be used to configure the core switch

- Cable Type:** Use multi-strand pre-terminated fiber optic cables with LC connectors for reliable, low-loss connections. These cables are factory-tested and reduce installation time and errors.
- Topology Considerations:** Star topology is common for core switch setups, where all devices connect to a central switch to optimize performance and reduce collisions.
- Port Aggregation:** For higher throughput or redundancy, consider LACP (802.3ad) port aggregation using SFP+ links between switches.
