Professional color coding serves multiple critical functions in enterprise network infrastructure: Performance-Based Network Segmentation: Different colors can designate specific bandwidth requirements, with lime green OM5 reserved for high-performance applications while orange OM2 handles standard. For single mode fiber, these colors are most commonly yellow or blue.
