Selection Guidelines

- Match fiber type to optical module:** Single-mode modules require single-mode jumpers; multimode modules require multimode jumpers.
- Match connector type to module port:** Ensure the jumper connector matches the optical module interface (e.g., LC for SFP, SC for GBIC).
- Consider transmission distance and data rate:** Single-mode fibers are preferred for long distances and high-speed links, while multimode fibers are suitable for short distances with high bandwidth.
- Determine jumper length:** Based on onsite cabling distance to ensure proper connection.
