- Branch circuit breakers:** Protect individual branch circuits from overloads and short circuits.
- Branch leakage protectors:** Provide additional safety for each branch circuit.
- Switchgear:** May include switches and fuses for controlling and protecting circuits. This level ensures that power is safely and efficiently distributed to multiple areas or equipment groups ().

Third-Level Distribution Box (Final Switch Box) The third-level box, also called the switch box, is located at the end of the distribution system and directly powers electrical equipment. Its components typically include:
