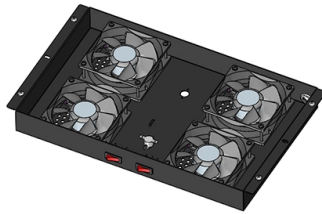


What is the horizontal arrangement of the distribution box
