Clearance and access: Maintain at least 36-42 inches between rows for safe access and maintenance. Planning for Future Growth: Reserve 15-20% of rack space and power capacity for future expansion or reconfiguration. Modular rack designs allow scaling independently based on density needs. Ensure PDUs and cooling units are located close to high-density zones to reduce inefficiencies.
