Best Practices Always inspect the connector with a fiberscope before and after cleaning to ensure no dust or scratches remain. Dispose of used wipes or cleaning strips properly to avoid recontamination. Ensure lasers are turned off before cleaning to prevent eye injury. Avoid touching the cleaning surface with your hands or placing it on unclean surfaces.
