Coaxial Patch Panels Coaxial patch panels are used in TV, AV, CCTV, and other audio/visual networks. They terminate coaxial cables and provide a central point for managing multiple connections. Ports are designed for coaxial connectors, and these panels simplify troubleshooting and reduce cable clutter in AV installations.
