This simplifies optical coupling and enables the use of lower-cost light sources like VCSELs. However, because different modes travel at slightly different speeds, multimode fibers experience modal dispersion, which limits their effective transmission distance. They are commonly used for short-distance applications, such as local area networks (LANs) and intra-data-center links.

Dual-Mode / Dual-Fiber Modules The term "dual-mode" is often used in networking to describe dual-fiber modules, which utilize two separate fibers: one for transmitting and one for receiving data. This configuration provides stable bidirectional communication and is easier to set up compared to single-fiber bidirectional (BiDi) modules.
