- ST, FC, MTP/MPO connectors:** Used in legacy or high-density applications.

The connector type on your control panel should match the fiber cable and transceiver module used in your system.

Industrial Control Panels For industrial fire-alarm or automation control panels, such as Siemens Desigo or FireFinder XLS systems, fiber-optic interface modules are used. These modules are mounted inside the panel enclosure and use SC-style duplex fiber connectors for RS-485 communication between main and remote panels. Each module typically has two fiber connectors for duplex communication, and the modules can be mounted on standard card cages or CAB-series enclosures.

How to Identify the Connector Locate the fiber patch panel or interface module inside or on the control panel. Check the front of the panel for ports labeled with fiber types (LC, SC, etc.). Verify the cable ty...
