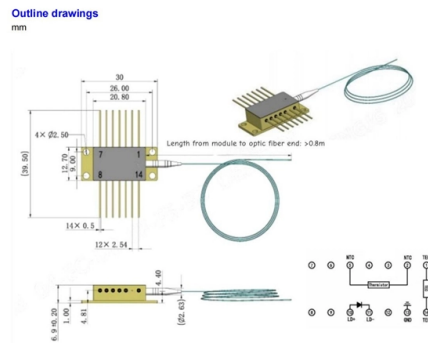


Where to install the fiber optic junction box
