

Which one is the fiber optic light on the router

- Restart Equipment:** Power cycle your router and any connected ONT (Optical Network Terminal) to reset the connection.
- Verify Power:** Make sure the router's power light is on. If not, check the power cable, adapter, and outlet.
- Check for ISP Issues:** Log in to your ISP account or contact support to see if there are reported outages in your area.
- Test LAN and Wi-Fi:** If the fiber light is solid but you still have no internet, check that LAN ports and Wi-Fi are active and functioning.

Additional LED Indicators

- Power Light:** Solid indicates the router is powered; off indicates no power.
- LOS (Loss of Signal):** Should normally be off; red or blinking indicates a fiber issue.
- LAN/Wi-Fi Lights:** Flicker when devices are connected and transmitting data; off indicates no activity or disabled Wi-Fi.
