

Which port is the fiber optic cable in the router

A fiber optic cable connects to an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which then links to your router via the WAN port. The WAN port is typically labeled "WAN," "Internet," or sometimes color-coded to distinguish it from LAN ports. Power and Configuration: Power on both the ONT and the router. Access the router's admin panel to enter any ISP credentials if required and ensure the connection is active. Key Points The fiber cable does not plug directly into a standard router; the ONT is required for signal conversion. Some fiber-ready routers have SFP or dedicated fiber ports, but in most residential setups, the ONT-to-router Ethernet connection is standard. Always handle fiber connectors carefully to avoid damage or signal loss. By following this setup, your router receives the internet feed via its WAN port, allowing you to distribute the connection to devices through Wi-Fi or Ethernet.
