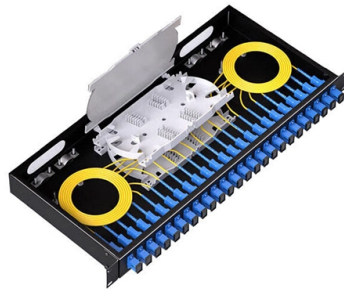


Which side of the power distribution box has the live wire



Overview

Live (L) Wire Connection: In a distribution box setup, the incoming live wire (also known as phase or hot wire, denoted as L or Line) connects to the line terminal of the circuit breaker. This serves as the primary source of electrical energy from the mains supply. Single Phase Distribution Box generally consists of Double Pole MCBs, Single Pole MCBs, and RCCBs. TL;DR: “Line” refers to the wires bringing power into a device from the source; “load” refers to wires carrying power out to devices further down the circuit. Arrangement order: The circuit breakers should be arranged from left to right, and the reserved position is generally placed on the right side of the distribution box. **Wire color:** The neutral wire is blue, and the color of the phase wire (A phase is yellow, B phase is green, and C phase is red). Distribution board is a safe system designed for house or building that included protective devices, isolator switches, circuit breaker and fuses to safely connect the cables and wires to the sub circuits and final sub circuits including their associated Live (Phase) Neutral and Earth conductors.

The wire that reads live is the line wire — it carries constant voltage from the panel. The wire that reads dead with nothing else connected downstream is the load wire; it only becomes live once the device
