Bonding Agents Applying a bonding agent or slurry coat between layers can significantly improve the connection, reducing permeability and increasing load-bearing capacity. Timing and Pour Management Minimize the time gap between pours; ideally, the second layer should be placed within 30 minutes of the first to prevent cold joint formation. If delays are unavoidable, use mechanical keys or dowels to reinforce the joint. Reinforcement Incorporate steel dowels or rebar across the joint to enhance structural continuity and durability, especially in load-bearing areas.
