Fusion splicing, in particular, produces a highly reliable connection with attenuation as low as 0.1 dB, while mechanical splicing offers a quick, practical solution for temporary or field repairs with slightly higher loss around 0.3 dB . Methods of Splicing Fusion Splicing: Uses heat or an electric arc to fuse fiber ends together, creating a permanent, low-loss connection ideal for long-haul networks . Mechanical Splicing: Aligns fibers using a mechanical assembly and index-matching gel, allowing for rapid installation or temporary connections . This method is useful for quick repairs or situations where a fusion splicer is unavailable. Practical Applications Network Expansion: Joining multiple cable spools to extend backbone or campus networks . Cable Repair: Restoring connectivity after accidental cuts or damage, often in buried or hard-to-access cables . Connecting Different Fiber Types: Splicing allows integration of cables with different fiber counts or specifications, such as linking a 48-fiber cable to several 12-fiber cab...
