- Wire Sizing and Insulation:** Use correct wire gauge for the expected load to prevent overheating. Insulation must meet voltage and environmental requirements.
- Protection Devices:** Each circuit should have its own breaker or fuse. Surge protection may be included for sensitive equipment.
- Labeling:** Clearly label all circuits, breakers, and hazards to prevent operational errors and facilitate maintenance.
- Accessibility and Clearance:** Panels must be installed in dry, accessible areas with adequate working space. Recommended heights are 1-1.8 meters for residential units and specific dimensions for industrial panels (e.g., IP54 enclosures with max width 1.5 m, height 1.2 m, depth 0.5 m).
- Environmental Protection:** Select enclosures and components suitable for the environment (e.g., outdoor use requires IP54 or higher).
