

# Wiring method for bottom incoming line of distribution box

The bottom incoming line of a distribution box should use a five-wire system: three-phase lines, one neutral, and one ground, connected to the appropriate terminals and circuit breakers according to load type and safety standards.

**Incoming Line Configuration** For a standard distribution box, the incoming line typically uses a five-wire system: Three-phase lines (A, B, C): Usually colored yellow, green, and red, these carry the main electrical current from the source to the distribution system. Special two-phase 380V equipment uses any two phases plus ground, with neutral added if local control requires it. **Connection to Circuit Breakers** Live (phase) wires: Connect to the line terminals of the circuit breakers. For single-pole (1P) breakers, only the live wire passes through the breaker; the neutral bypasses it and connects directly to the neutral busbar. Neutral wire: Connect to the neutral busbar. For 2P breakers, both live and neutral wires are connected to the breaker poles and are disconnected simultaneously when tripped. Ground wire: Connect to the ground busbar. For breakers with residual current protection (RCD), the PE wire may also connect to the breaker's dedicated terminal. If using a 4-pin circuit breaker, the three-phase lines and neutral enter together, while the ground is pressed to the grounding terminal block. **Installation Considerations** Ensure the distribution box is firmly fixed, horizontally and vertically aligned, with no gaps around the edges. Use split bolts or expansion bolts for wall mounting, or embed wood bricks for smaller boxes. Maintai...
