4. **Integrate Automatic Transfer or Switching:** A transfer switch or automatic changeover device is recommended to switch between primary and secondary power without interrupting elevator operation. Ensure the system can handle regenerative energy if the elevator generates power during descent.
5. **Grounding and Bonding:** Follow NEC Article 250 for grounding and bonding. All metal enclosures, dis...
