Conduits, such as PVC or metal, protect the cable from physical damage and moisture. For aerial wiring, ensure proper support and clearance from structures.

Outdoor Junction Boxes and Outlets Install weatherproof outdoor junction boxes at connection points to protect wires from moisture, dirt, and physical damage. These boxes should have sealed gaskets and be rated for outdoor use. Outdoor outlets must be GFCI-protected and housed in weather-resistant enclosures with "in-use" covers to prevent water ingress. All connections must remain accessible for maintenance and inspection, as required by NEC Article 314.
