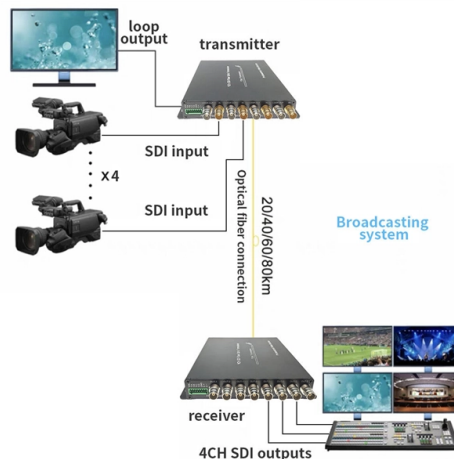

- RCCBs (Residual Current Circuit Breakers):** Detect leakage currents and disconnect power to prevent electric shocks. They are essential for domestic and industrial installations where personnel safety is a priority ().
- Earth/Ground Bars:** Provide a safe path for fault currents to dissipate into the ground, protecting both equipment and personnel ().
- Emergency Power Shutdown Wiring:**
 - Emergency Break Devices:** Should disconnect all live conductors, including neutral, but not protective earth (PE). They must operate under load and in a single action ().
 - Placement:** Emergency breakers should be easily accessible and clearly identifiable, ideally near the equipment or circuits they protect. Remote placement is allowed if it remains accessible and visible to operating staff ().
 - Integration:** Emergency shutdown devices can be integrated with main or secondary distribution boards, ensuring that all local...
