

Wiring system of three-level distribution box

A three-level distribution box uses a main MCCB, branch MCBs, busbars, and neutral/earth links to safely distribute three-phase power across multiple circuits while maintaining load balance and protection.

Overview A three-level distribution box, also called a three-phase distribution board, is designed to receive power from a three-phase supply and distribute it to multiple circuits while ensuring safety, efficiency, and load balance across all three phases. It is commonly used in industrial, commercial, and large residential buildings.

Components and Layout

- Main Switch (MCCB):** The main circuit breaker (MCCB) acts as the primary protection against overcurrent and short circuits. It receives the three-phase input and distributes power to the branch circuits.
- Branch Circuit Breakers (MCBs):** Each output circuit is protected by a 3-pole MCB for three-phase loads or single-pole MCBs for single-phase loads. The MCBs are connected to the main MCCB via busbars to handle high current safely.
- Residual Current Devices (RCCBs):** If required, an RCCB is installed after the main MCCB to provide protection against earth leakage. The output of the RCCB is then connected to the branch MCBs.
- Busbars:** Copper or aluminum busbars are used to connect the main MCCB to all branch MCBs. Busbars ensure efficient current distribution and reduce the risk of overheating compared to individual wires.
- Neutral and Earth Links:** Neutral links distribute the neutral conductor to all circuits, while earth links provide a common grounding point. Multiple neutral links, if present, should be interconnected to maintain continuity.

Wiring Procedure

- Select Ratings:** Determine the MCCB and MCB ratings based on load requirements and expected current.
- Connect Input Power:** Connect the three-phase supply lines to the input terminals of the MCCB. Connect the neutral wire to the neu...
