Avoid using the neutral conductor as a grounding path. Ensure all connections are tight and free of corrosion to prevent inaccurate readings ().

Temporary Construction Wiring Compliance: Construction wiring must be distinguishable from permanent wiring, insulated, and positioned to avoid mechanical damage from cranes or vehicles. Use color-coded sheaths or marked tape for easy identification ().

Testing and Verification: After wiring, perform a visual inspection and verify connections with a multimeter. Measure the resistance to ensure it meets safety standards (typically b...
